The event is the 2022 IPSC Australia National Championships, Handgun-Rifle-Shotgun.

The event owner is IPSC Australia with IPSC Northern Territory (IPSCNT) hosting the Championships at Top End Practical Shooting League (TEPSL), Chibnall Rd Acacia NT.


Preamble

The 2022 IPSC Australia National Championships is intended to be structured with two handgun matches so as to give all IPSC Australia Competitors and Range Officers an EQUAL opportunity to compete in a Level III Main Match.

The Northern Territory's 'Top End Practical Shooting League' is fortunate to have the facilities to host all four Championships in one location. This gives competitors that may not regularly compete in a long arm championship the rare opportunity to combine it with their handgun Nationals in one trip.

For those members not officiating at this event, it provides the opportunity to compete in your favoured division as well as compete in another divison of choice at the national level.

Having the two Main Matches will allow those qualified Range Officers who do not normally officiate at the Nationals, as they usually compete in the main match, the chance to not only compete but to gain valuable experience in being a Range Officer at a Level III.





The event is scheduled to be held over six days of competition:

- Handgun -
- o Two days Optic
 - o Two days Iron Sight
- Rifle and Shotgun two days

A Range Officer seminar is scheduled prior to the Handgun Main Matches with the IPSC Australia Mid-Year Meeting to be held between the Handgun and Long-arm matches.

There will be no pre-match for this event as in past nationals, however Range Officers, Sponsors and Match Officials will have the opportunity to shoot one of the Main Matches.

The venue is the TEPSL complex at Acacia. TEPSL has proven its capacity to be able to hold the Championships having hosted past Handgun, Rifle and Shotgun National Championships along with numerous Handgun, Rifle and Shotgun Titles.

- TEPSL was the venue for the 2007, 2009 and 2015 National Championships and various State Titles (handgun/rifle/shotgun).
- TEPSL has approval from NT Firearms Branch to construct a further six ranges in addition to the current 17 ranges available including the shotgun 'Gully' range and a 500m Rifle range.
- TEPSL has adequate amenities for all competitors, spectators, car parking, catering, shade, camping etc.
- TEPSL is only 65 km from the Darwin CBD with year-round access. For those that have travelled out to TEPSL in the past, Chibnall Road is now bitumen until the intersection at Leonino Road, leaving about 1.5 km of gravel road to TEPSL.
- TEPSL is an IPSC only club which can also boast facilities for helicopter joy rides during the event.





Permits/Licensing

IPSCNT will arrange a 'blanket permit' for the duration of the event. The permit will cover those competitors attending the Championships and for those that intend to travel after the event.

Please note, anyone competing at the Championships will need to have the applicable firearms licence or permit. Competitors that do not have a licence will unfortunately not be able to compete due to NT Firearms legislation.



Range Officers

Typical arrangements will be in place for the Range Officers, accommodation, entry to the event, catering and Presentation BBQ. Transport to and from the airport/range is also included.

For these Championships an estimated 70 Range Officers will be required over the two handgun matches. This also includes the Stats Team and CROs.





The Championships

The structure of these Championships will include:

- 18 stages for each Handgun Main Match
 - Main Match Optic Open, Production Optic and Production Optic Light
 - Main Match Iron Sight Standard, Classic, Production and Revolver
- 8 stages each for Rifle and Shotgun Main Match
- Minimum of 330 rounds for each Handgun Main Match
- Minimum of 120 rounds for Rifle and 100 rounds for Shotgun.





Budget

The entry fees for these Championships are as follows:

- One Match 15 June 2021 to 28 February 2022
 - \$300 general entry
 - \$200 spouse/partner
 - \$100 Junior & Super Junior
- Additional Handgun Match
 - \$150 general entry
 - \$100 spouse/partner
 - \$50 Junior & Super Junior
- Rifle and Shotgun matches
 - \$80 Rifle and Shotgun
- Event Bundle, all four events [Optic & Iron Sight, Rifle & Shotgun]
 - \$500 general Entry
 - \$350 spouse/partner
 - \$200 Junior & Super Junior

Entries and payments received after 28 February 2022 will incur a late fee of \$100. Entries close 31 May 2022.

IPSCNT is seeking sponsorship and government assistance for the event.





Tourism

IPSCNT is in contact with Tourism NT to obtain as much travel information for competitors so that they are able to make suitable travel arrangements.

A dedicated IPSC webpage is being developed by Tourism NT to assist competitors with their travel arrangements. The link will be provided on the IPSC Australia web site.

Anyone that is thinking about entering the event should look at booking accommodation as soon as possible due to the influx of visitors into the NT during the 'dry season'.
