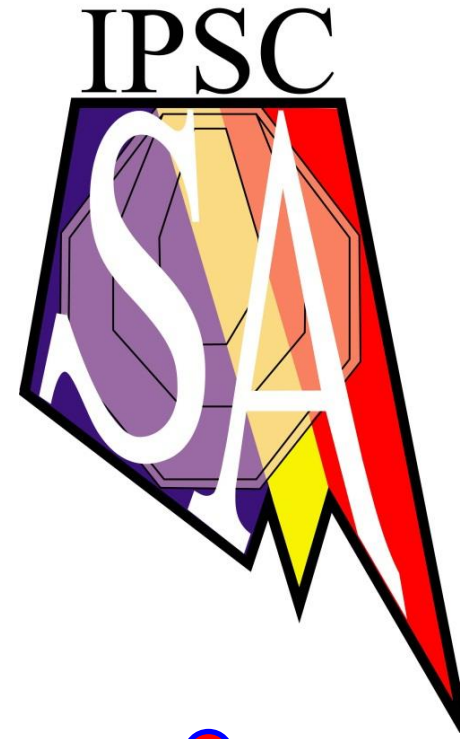

*** COVID-19 ***

As you are well aware, SA has introduced a gambit of measures intended to restrict the propagation of the COVID-19 virus and these can be found at www.covid-19.sa.gov.au. It is the responsibility of the individual to make themselves aware of and comply with these regulations.

In accordance with the regulations, Impact Practical Shooting League and IPSC (SA) has developed and issued a COVID-Safe Plan – a copy of which may be consulted at the Stats Office.

In addition, there is the requirement for **ALL** staff, official, competitors, spectators and visitors to register their presence on the IPSL premises using either the SA GOV App and the QR Codes that are posted around the range or, alternatively, by filling in the paper form available. This must be done each day.

The COVID-Safe Plan also imposes restrictions on the number of people in certain areas – for example, the IPSL clubhouse is restricted to 5 persons (plus staff) and is not to be used for consumption of food or drink, only the serving of same.

Of specific note is the enforcement of numbers of people on a Stage – after the walkthrough, only people actually restoring the stage and the next shooter will be permitted on the Stage.

At the time of writing, there is no requirement for the use of masks in outdoor areas but masks must be used if inside the clubhouse, main shed and toilets.

COVID Marshalls are in attendance and are identified by vests or armbands and are:

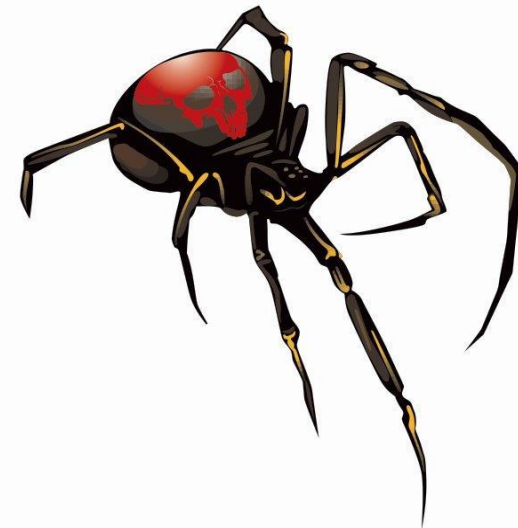

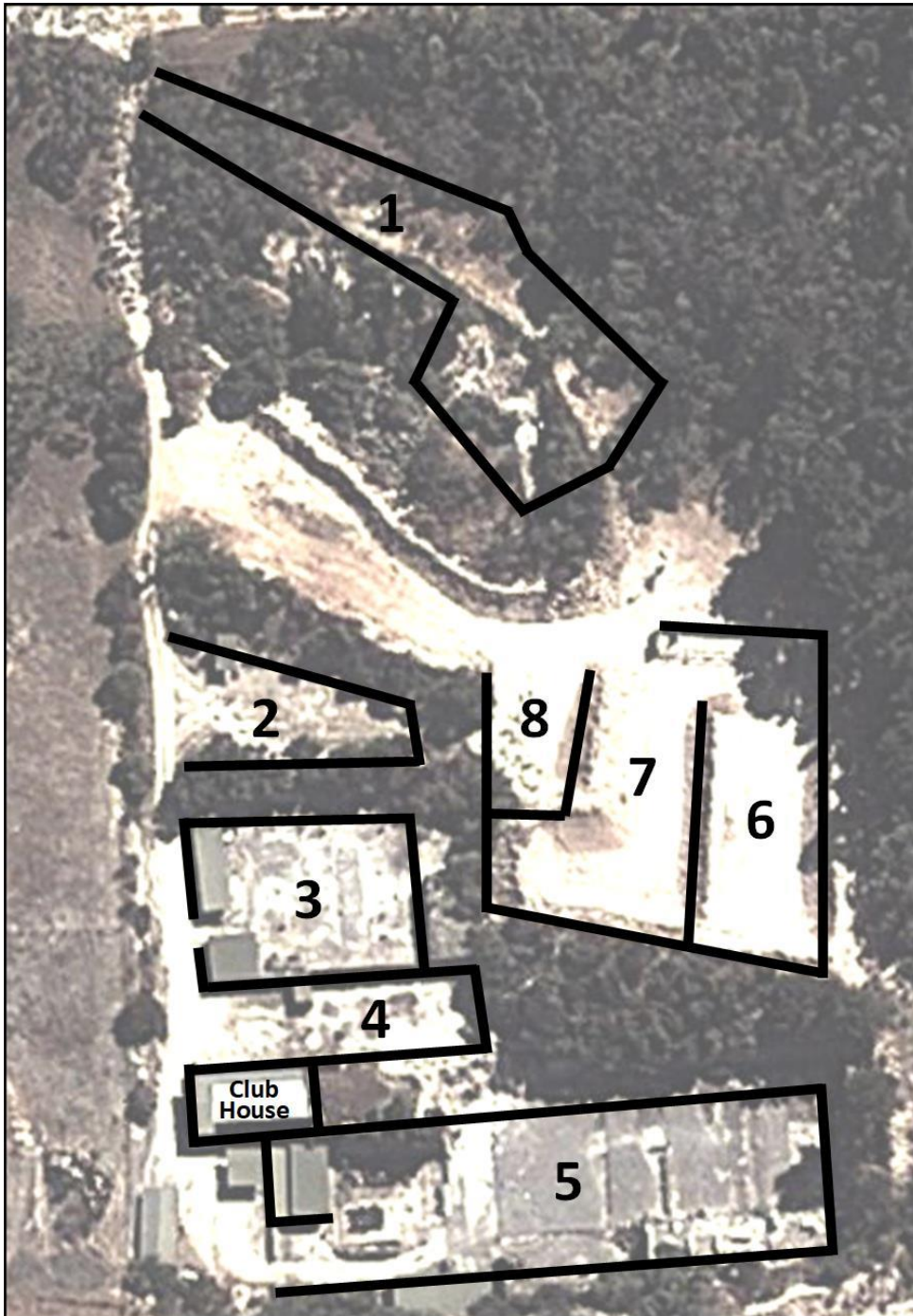
These officials have the authority to confirm individual check-in and to enforce the COVID-Safe Plan. Please comply with any instructions issued by these officials without fuss.

Most importantly I hope that all Competitors who have travelled from Interstate and within South Australia have a great match and enjoy their time in South Australia

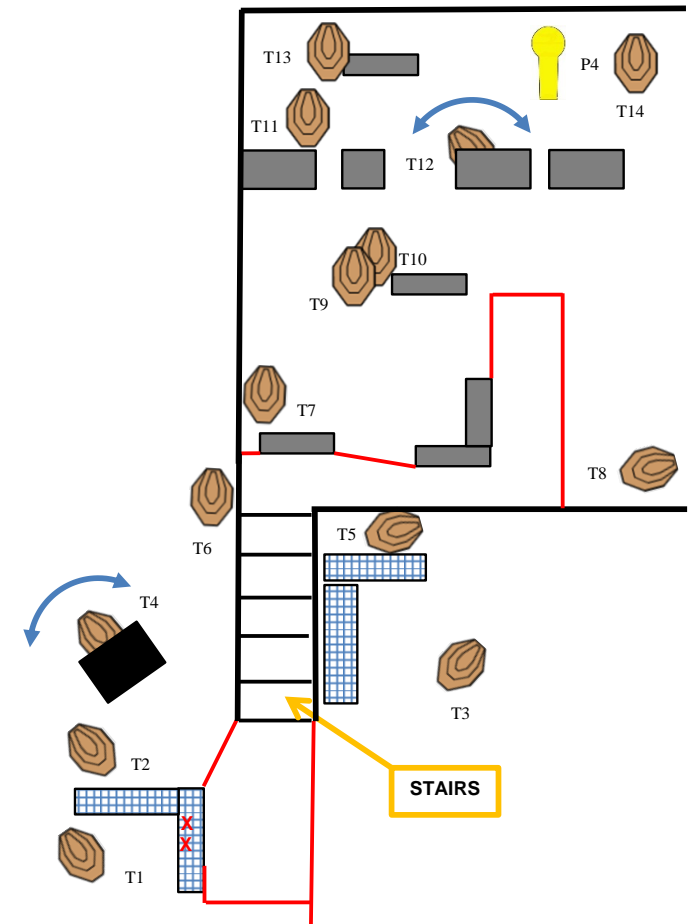
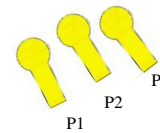

MATCH & RANGE INFORMATION

Arbitration

Arbitration Request Forms will be available at each stage. Ask the RO for assistance in retaining evidence of the incident. Arbitration Request Forms must be lodged with the Range Master within one (1) hour of the incident.

- **Fee:** AUD 100.00.

Compliance Testing

- **Gun & Equipment:** Gun and equipment checks will be carried out at Registration but may be carried out randomly during the competition and also at the Chronograph area. All ROs are authorised to conduct gun and equipment checks at any time.
- **Ammunition:** Ammunition will be tested at the Chronograph. The Range Master may require any Competitor to undertake additional chronograph testing of his/her ammunition at any time.
- **Division Compliance:** The Range Master may also require the conduct of compliance testing for any or all of the specific requirements of any Division for any Competitor at any time.

Eye and Ear Protection

Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times on the ranges by all competitors, spectators and anyone coming onto the ranges.

Firearms Licence

It is a requirement that you carry your H Class firearms licence at all times whilst in possession of a Handgun in SA.

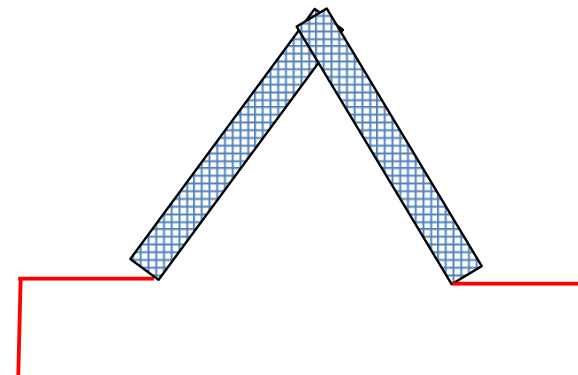
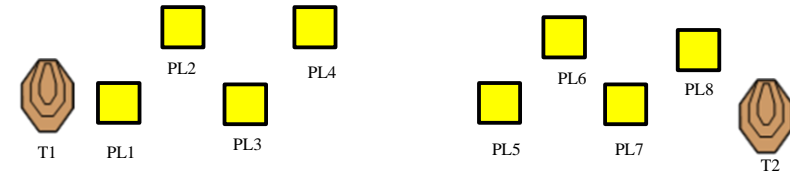
Lunch

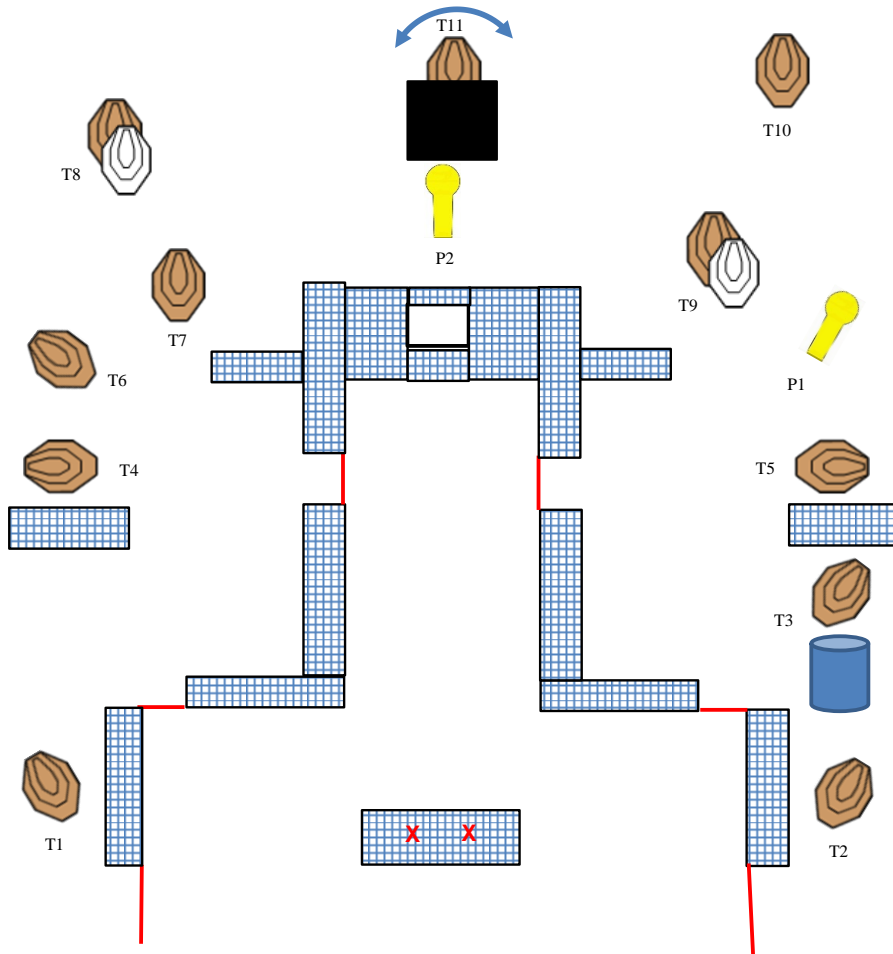
Problem Reports are available at each stage or from the Range Master and should be lodged with the Range Master. Verbal requests will not be attended to.

Photography and Video

Please exercise due care and the direction of the ROs in this matter and be very careful that items posted in the public domain (eg YouTube, Facebook) do not reflect badly on IPSC or shooting sports in general. At all times the published IPSC Australia Policy “Social Media” will apply.

Release & Waiver

It is a condition of competing in this Match that all Competitors have read and then signified their acceptance of the *Release & Waiver* at the time of online entry. If you have any concerns about this undertaking, please contact the Match organisers immediately.

Restricted Areas

Competitors are to remain outside of any area marked or flagged as restricted.

Rules and Scoring

Rules and scoring will be in accordance with the *IPSC Handgun Competition Rules, January 2019 Edition*.

Scoring on stages will be conducted using the IPSC Electronic Score Sheet (ESS).

Safety Areas

Safety Areas are provided around the ranges and are clearly marked.

Scheduling

Your squad is scheduled to shoot at specific times as shown in the Squad Schedule. Occasionally stages will run ahead of schedule but only if your entire squad is assembled and with the consent of the Range Officer will you be permitted to shoot ahead of time. If you are late for your scheduled time, you will be given a zero score on that stage. Exceptional circumstances should be reported to the Range Master for judgement.

Shooting Order

Shooting order will be in accordance with the IROA-sanctioned shooting order definition. Your RO will inform your squad of the order at each Stage and it must be adhered to.

Squadding

Whilst every attempt has been made to accommodate squadding requests, it may just not be possible. Squad allocation is not negotiable.

All Competitors are required to participate fully in their squad and assist with patching and brass pick-up in support of their colleagues.

Stage Inspection

When your squad is assembled at the scheduled time, you will be given a compliant Stage briefing by the Range Officer. After that, you will be permitted three (3) minutes to "walkthrough" the Course of Fire and you may negotiate obstacles and ask questions at that time.

Only the next Competitor will be permitted to be on the Stage other than for the purposes of target restoration, re-setting and brass collection.

Access to Stages prior to the designated briefing and walkthrough is not permitted at any time.

Stats Office

No unauthorised person may enter the Stats Office at any time.

Time to Shoot

When called to the line, you are expected to be ready to proceed promptly under the Range Officer's instruction. Uncasing and casing the firearm before and after each stage is discouraged.

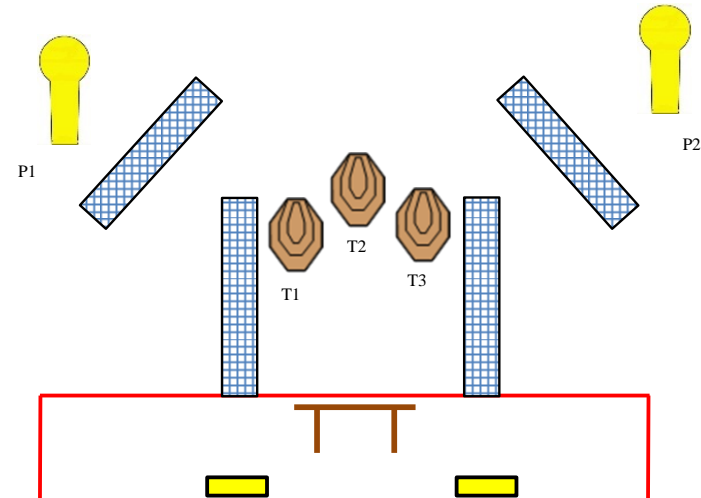
Weather Policy

Your Scores

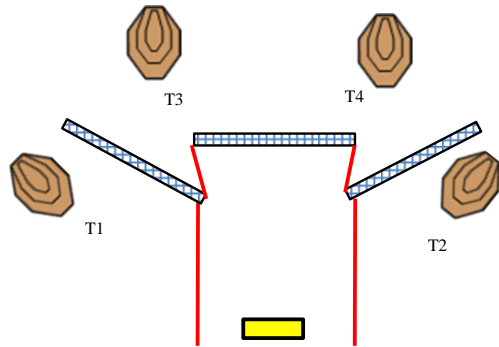
