1 **GENERAL**

These criteria supersede all previously published IPSC Australia criteria for the characteristics required of a Team Manager.

These criteria may be amended by the IPSC Australia Executive from time to time.

2 CRITERIA

2.1 Mandatory

The Team Manager and Assistant Team Manager must:

- be a financial member of IPSC Australia;
- have a minimum of 5 years continuous experience in the sport at a national/international level in the last 7 years;
- have demonstrate past and present commitment to IPSC;
- have a proven record of ethical behaviour;
- have access to and capacity to utilise communications systems for the purposes of obtaining and sending information in a rapid and timely manner;
- hold a current and not suspended Australian drivers licence;
- hold a current Australian passport;
- display an in-depth knowledge of the current IPSC rules;
- display a sound knowledge of the basis of the IPSC scoring methodology;
- have a high level of effective interpersonal and written communications skills;
- demonstrate an ability to manage, lead and coordinate individuals in a team environment;
- have capacity to coordinate all international travel and customs arrangements for team members;
- display willingness to assist ALL team members during the pre- and post-match phases of an event;
- display commitment to assist ALL team members to the maximum extent during a match;
- state commitment to attend the national/international events as specified by the IPSC Australia Executive in the period of their appointment;
- participate in any Team Selection Committee activities including attending any Team Selection Committee meeting(s); and
- sign the Code of Conduct and Team Member Agreement.

2.2 Desirable

The Team Manager and Assistant Team Manager should:

- have experience as a Range Officer/Stats Officer and have attended a Level 1 RO course;
- display an understanding of both the ESS and WINMSS scoring systems; and
- if required by the IPSC Australia Executive, be prepared to attend the Mid-Year Meeting and/or the Annual General Meeting
