IPSC Australia Range Officers Code of Conduct

To ensure a safe environment at IPSC Events Range Officers have been given authority over all participants and observers and are subsequently expected to behave with professionalism and courtesy at all times.

Members of the National Range Officers Institute (including members of the International Range Officers Association) enjoy privileges and responsibilities in relation to the conduct of IPSC events and shall acknowledge and respect their responsibilities and duties to both IPSC events and to other match officials.

In particular Range Officers will:

1. Conduct themselves with dignity both at and away from the event and shall by example endeavour to inspire the true principles of the rules.
2. Not cause the Confederation to become involved in any controversial matters and shall abide by the Rules of IPSC as set by the World body.
3. Adhere to all standards and directives.
4. Always comply with the dress code and maintain a high level of physical appearance.
5. Be knowledgeable in relation to the current IPSC rules and be aware of all rule changes and enforce all such rule changes.
6. Perform their designated responsibility including attending organised updates, courses or meetings and shall assist their colleagues in upgrading their skills and improving the standard of officiating, instructing and assessing.
7. Honour any appointments made for or accepted by them unless unable to do so by virtue of illness or personal emergency.
8. Not publicly criticise other officials, competitors or any other shooting association, nor shall they make any statements to the media related to any event in which they were involved; and
9. Be subject to disciplinary action for any breach of this code of conduct.
